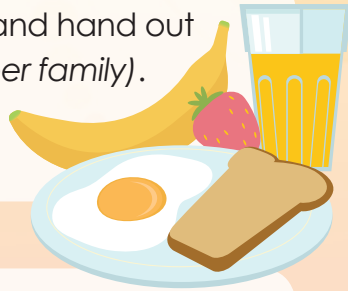


1 Serve breakfast and hand out raffle tickets (one per family).



2 Have Moms introduce their kids and say, "I'm proud of (child's name) this month because..."

3 Say this before starting the video clip – "Peer pressure is such a big issue with our children these days. How should we Moms respond? Let's watch."



4 After the video say, "I love that acronym **F-R-I-E-N-D**. What a great way to help us remember how to handle peer pressure!"

5 Give out the discussion cards or show the questions on your PowerPoint presentation and say, "Let's take a few minutes and talk about this month's discussion questions."



6 Give the moms their monthly iMOM Time Challenge - "OK, thanks for sharing with each other, now Moms and kids, here's this month's iMom time challenge – show your kids your high school yearbook and point out one person who stood up to peer pressure and one who did not. Then discuss what happened to them. Let me know how it goes by putting a comment on our iMOM Morning Chapter page. I will share the best story next month, and if it's yours, we will give you an extra raffle ticket next month."

Raffle off your prizes, thank the kids for coming and then dismiss them to class.
